## **The annual award is designed to support the following activities:**

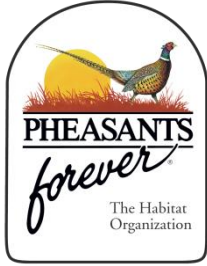
