









Northeast Pheasant Opportunity Area

Practices and Payment Rates for Private Land

FOCUS AREA OBJECTIVES

- Increase and improve available pheasant habitat.
- Increase access for public hunting opportunities using the Open Fields and Waters Program.



PAYMENTS FOR PUBLIC HUNTING ACCESS (OPEN FIELDS AND WATERS PROGRAM)

- Up to \$10/acre for new or high quality CRP
- \$50/acre signing incentive for 5 year contracts (\$2,500 maximum) (Cedar, Dixon, Dakota, Antelope)
- Open Fields and Waters (OFW) participants are protected from legal liability by the Nebraska Recreational Liability Act.





NEW VEGETATION ESTABLISHMENT

- Short-Term Set-Aside (2 years)
 - Annual rental payment (up to \$150/acre)
 - Small grain/legume cover crop planted year one; left standing undisturbed in year two
 - NGPC covers establishment cost



EARLY SUCCESSIONAL HABITAT MANAGEMENT ON ESTABLISHED CRP (MUST BE ENROLLED IN OFW)

- Incentive payment on Mid-Contract Management (MCM) activities on existing CRP and CCRP-disking, inter-seeding, prescribed fire, etc.
 - 25% of total cost up to \$50/acre (\$2,500 cap)
- Small grain firebreak establishment on interior of green firebreak
 - 100% of cost covered
